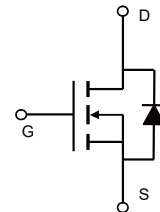

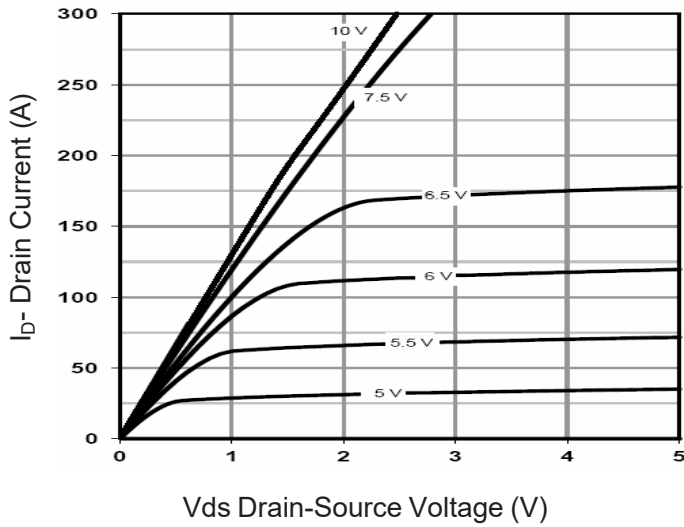


Figure 1 Output Characteristics

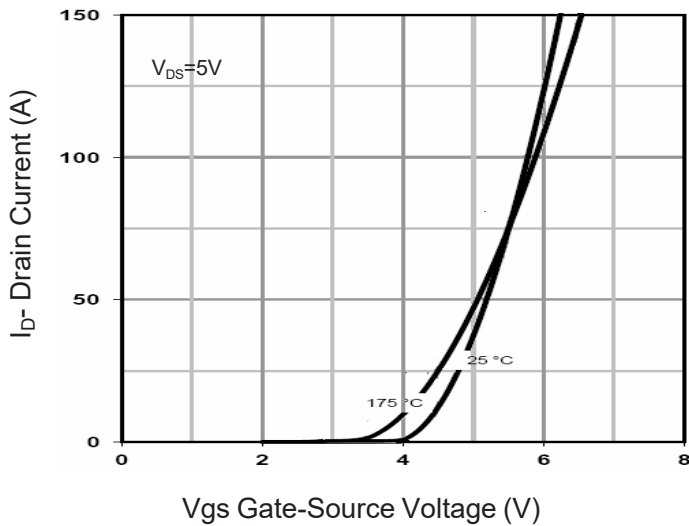


Figure 2 Transfer Characteristics

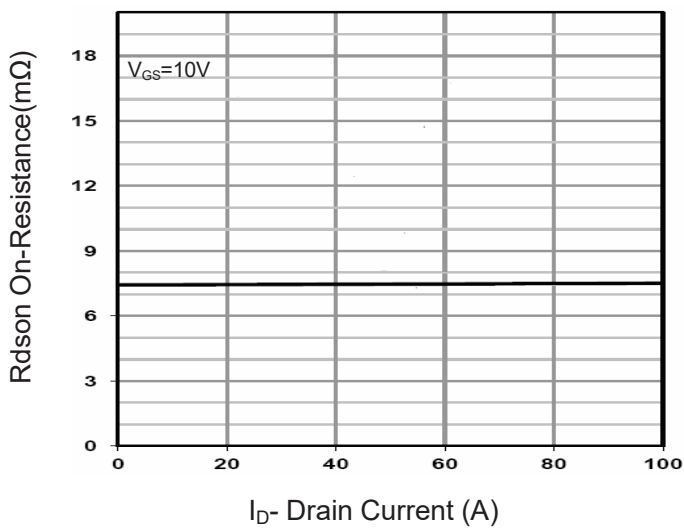


Figure 3 Rdson- Drain Current

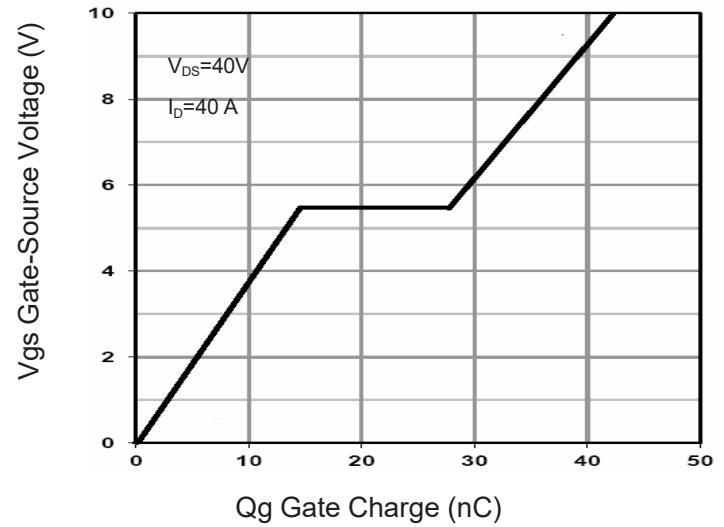


Figure 4 Gate Charge

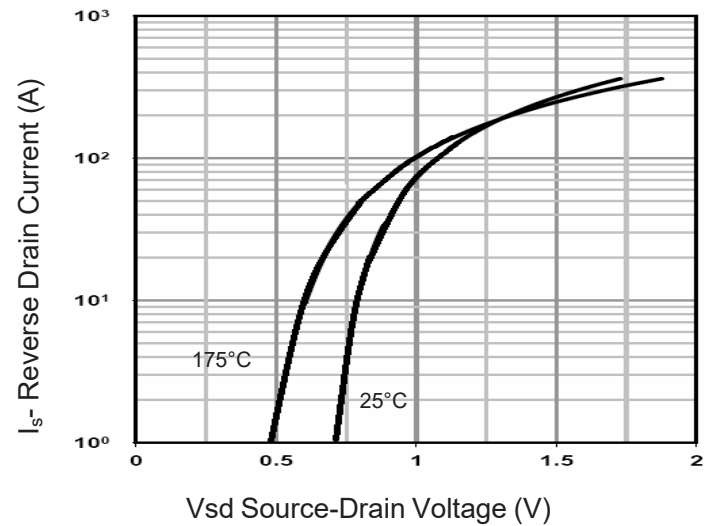


Figure 5 Source- Drain Diode Forward

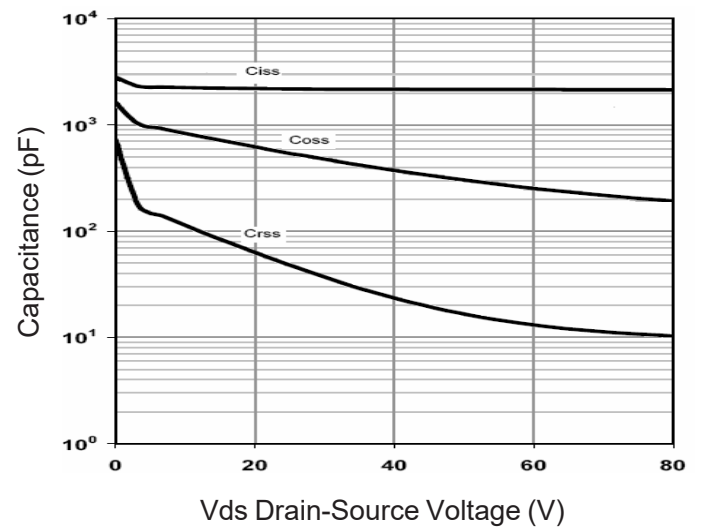
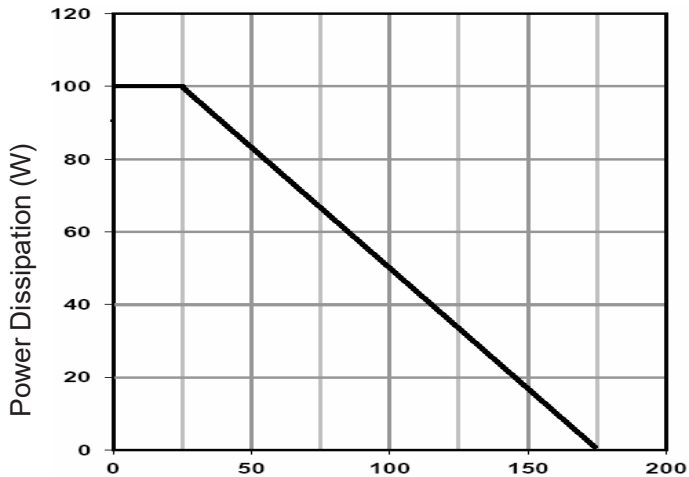
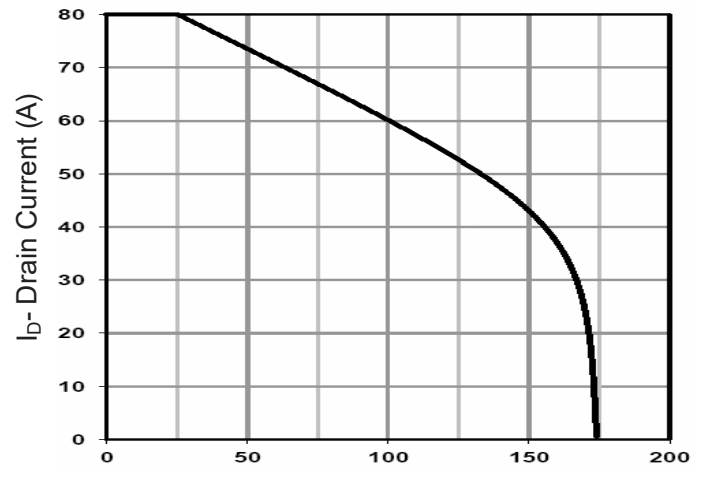


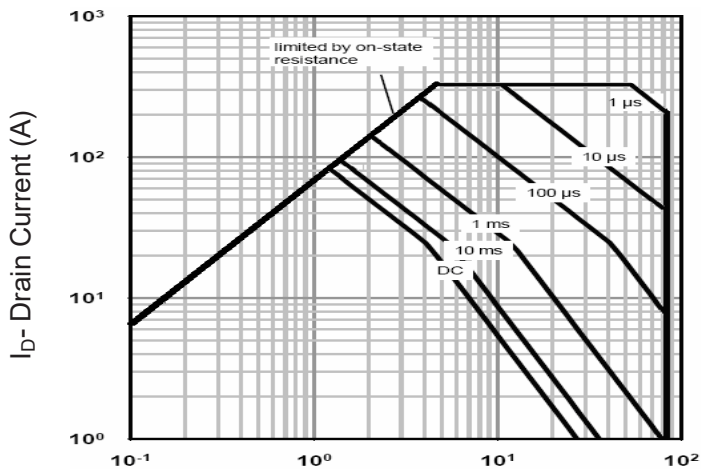
Figure 6 Capacitance vs Vds



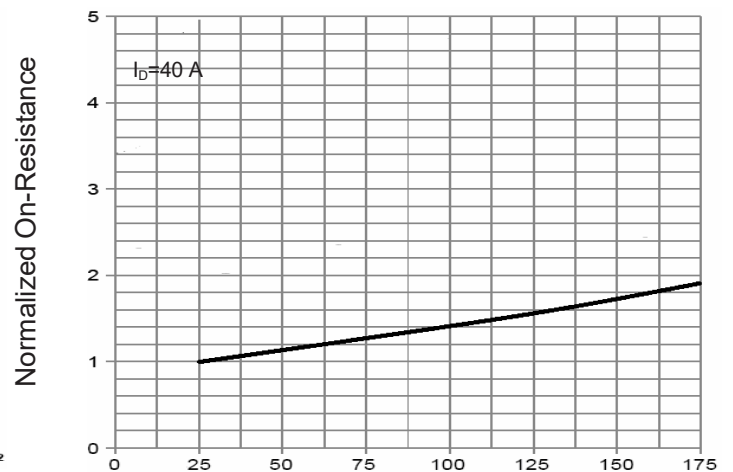

Figure 7 Power De-rating



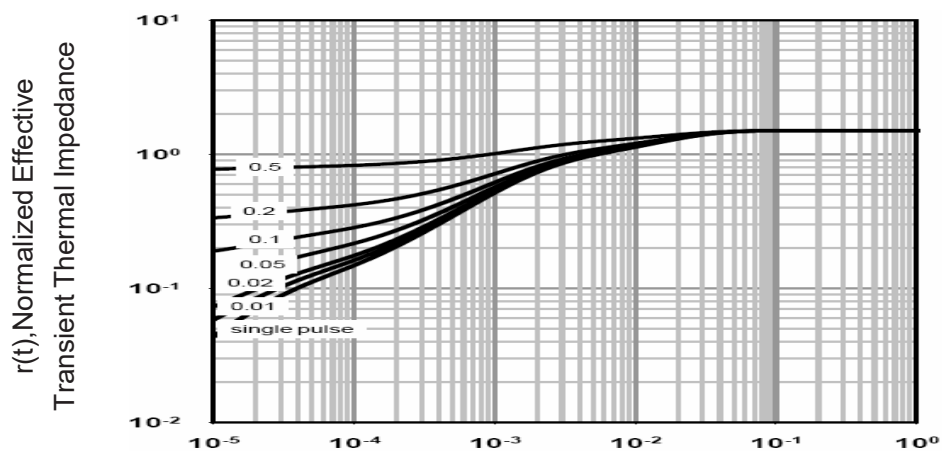
T_J -Junction Temperature (°C)
