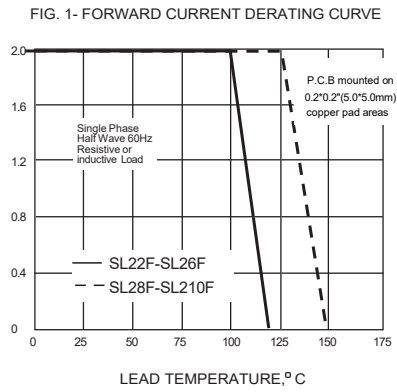

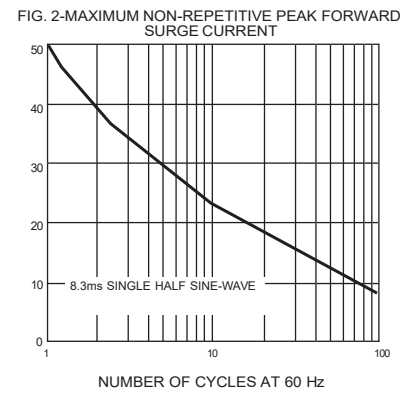

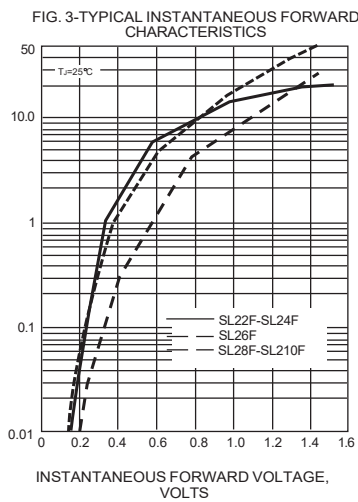
AVERAGE FORWARD RECTIFIED CURRENT,
AMPERES



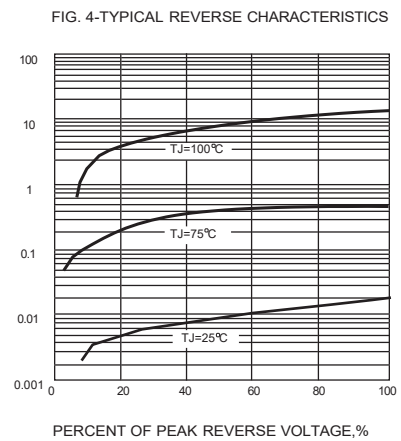
PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT,
AMPERES



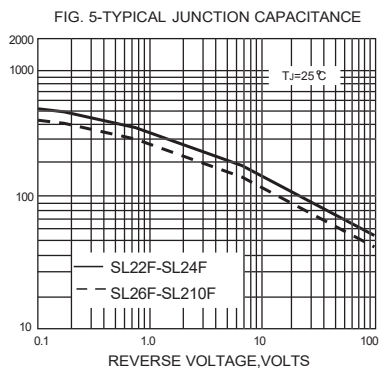
INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD
CURRENT, AMPERES



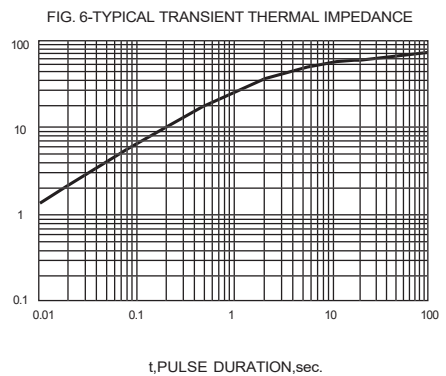
INSTANTANEOUS REVERSE CURRENT,
